







Grindleford village, located in the beautiful Peak District has become home to one of our natural climbing structures, blending in the countryside, the climbing structure was enjoyed by the children immediately after install and has bought excitement to the area, as well as a new space for the local community.

The climbing structure consists of a variety of components including a triangular and square platform, a rope bridge, a clamber net, a wobbly ladder, balance beams with overhead ropes and a fireman's pole.

The play space also features a snug den, tower built over existing slide to make a feature of it and a basket swing. These different features offer areas of play for different ages and abilities. The surfacing surrounding the play equipment is play chip which provides a natural surfacing, in keeping with the local environment.
